# M•E Companies, Inc. Scholarship Fund

The M•E Companies, Inc. Scholarship Fund is established by M•E Companies, Inc., a Columbus-based management and engineering firm with offices throughout Ohio. The scholarship fund includes two, \$1,000 scholarships awarded by M•E annually.

The primary objective of the scholarship fund is to foster college participation in students from southeastern Ohio. While students entering all career fields are eligible, there will be emphasis on awarding the scholarships to those applicants interested in pursuing study in the field of civil engineering at an accredited university.

## What qualifications do I need to be eligible?

The applicant must meet all of the following requirements.

- Attend a high school in one of the following counties for the past two years and plan to graduate from that high school in 2012. Eligible Counties: Adams, Athens, Fairfield, Hocking, Meigs, Morgan, Muskingum, Noble, Perry, Pickaway, Vinton or Washington. (*Special note: one scholarship will be awarded to an applicant from Perry County*).
- Graduate with a G.P.A. of 2.5 or better, based on a 4.0 scale.
- Participate in college preparatory courses as offered through high school.
- Enter the first year of a four-year program at an accredited college or university as a full time student in 2012.
- Lack full scholarship for tuition, room and board at time of award.
- Have a recommendation letter from each of the following:
  - Community member (preferably a community organization leader) who is not a relative.
  - High school teacher or advisor who is not a relative.
- Cannot be related to an M•E Companies, Inc. employee.

## Terms and conditions of scholarship

The scholarship is a one-time, \$1,000 grant payable directly to the college or university the recipient attends. The recipient will be asked to address high school students visiting M•E regarding their collegiate experience during National Engineer's Week, which takes place in February 2013.

## How do I get a scholarship application?
